Apprenticeship MOTOR VEHICLE SERVICE & MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN Level 3

Why study this course?

Are you interested in motor vehicles?

Do you have general analytical and problem solving skills?

Are you organised, methodical and have good attention to detail?

Who is the course aimed at?

Anyone who is new to the industry, or has a related qualification such as Motor Vehicle and wishes to further develop their skills base.

What will you study

- ▶ *Level 3 Apprenticeship in Motor Vehicle Service and Maintenance Technician (light vehicle)*
- ▶ *F-Gas qualifications in line with EU regulations involved with working on vehicle air conditioning systems*
- ▶ *Level 2 Functional Skills in Maths and English if appropriate*

Knowledge and skills you will develop

- ▶ *Good communication skills, both oral and written*
- ▶ *Teamwork*
- ▶ *Customer service*

Entry requirements.

An initial assessment of Maths and English will be carried out prior to enrolment, and an interview with a member of our assessment team.

A level 2 functional skills qualification is required and Maths and English will be studied as part of the qualification if the apprentice does not already have grade C/4 in both.

How long will it last?

Typical duration: 36 months

How will it be delivered?

Classroom based and observations in the workplace.

How will it be assessed?

On programme assessment will include various coaching and mentoring assessment methods. These assessments are designed to review the behaviours, knowledge and skills against set gateway criteria.

The final grading of the apprenticeship will be carried out through an End Point Assessment.

This consists of 4 stages:

- ▶ *Review of completed evidence within the eLogbook*
- ▶ *Knowledge Assessment*
- ▶ *Skills Assessment*
- ▶ *In-depth professional review*

Qualification gained

- ▶ *Level 3 Apprenticeship in Motor Vehicle Service and Maintenance Technician (light vehicle)*
- ▶ *F-Gas qualifications*
- ▶ *Level 2 Functional Skills in Maths and English (if required)*

Progression to further study

Successful apprentices can progress, if opportunity allows, onto:

- ▶ *Level 4 advanced diagnostics and managements*
- ▶ *MOT testing award*
