Entry requirements

- ▶ 5 GCSEs at Grade C (4) or above
- Level 1 qualification in English & maths or equivalent level through initial assessment
- Comprehensive skills scan

How long will it last?

Typical duration: 24 - 30 months

How will it be delivered?

The Diploma will be delivered by your tutor on a fortnightly basis at an agreed location.

Coaching towards End Point Assessment will take place in the workplace by your assessor.

Maths and English will be delivered on a flexible basis.

20% off-the-job training during contracted hours.

How will it be assessed?

The Diploma will be assessed by portfolio.

The Standard will be assessed through End Point Assessment once the apprentice, employer and assessor have agreed that the apprentice is EPA Gateway ready for:

- On-line knowledge test
- Portfolio evidence
- Competency based interview
- Presentation of work based project with Q&A
- Professional discussion relating to CPD

Qualification gained

- ► Level 5 Diploma For Leaders and Managers
- Institute for Apprenticeships (IFA) certificate
- Option for registration with professional bodies
- Level 2 Functional Skills in Maths and English (if required)

Progression to further study

Successful apprentices can progress, if opportunity allows, onto:
