Entry requirements

Initial assessments in maths and English. Comprehensive skills scan

How long will it last?

Typical duration: 15 Months

How will it be delivered?

The Foundation certificate will be delivered on a weekly basis in college.

Portfolio build coaching towards End Point Assessment will be delivered in the workplace. Maths and English will be delivered on a flexible basis. 20% off-the-job training during contracted hours.

How will it be assessed?

The AAT Certificate will be assessed by exams. The Standard will be assessed through End Point Assessment once the Apprentice, Employer and Assessor have agreed that the apprentice is EPA Gateway ready for:

- Structured interview (supported by portfolio of evidence)
- In-tray test

Qualification gained

- Level 2 AAT Foundation Certificate in Accounting
- Institute for Apprenticeships (IFA) certificate
- Maths and English Functional Skills if appropriate.

Progression to further study

Successful apprentices can progress, if opportunity allows, onto:

 Assistant Accountant Apprenticeship Level 3
